Take me to research inquire about local landlords to learn more about who you are ren ng from

- Is public transportation nearby or is it walking distance from the campus? (please remember, New Brunswick gets snow in the winter and you may not be able to use a bicycle or scooter. The weather can be very cold.)
- Does the place have the important things you are looking for? Remember, not
 everything on your list may be available as housing is limited, i.e. Are there parking
 space(s)?
 - o i.e., Is it pet friendly? What are the condi ons of having a pet?
- Are there laundry facili es onsite? Where are they? Is there a cost associated with them? Confirm hours of opera on.
- Do the bedroom doors have locks? (If you would like them! Not all students look for bedroom door locks.) If you are solely ren ng a room, it should have a lock.
- Do the windows open, dose and lock easily? They must have windows that meet code (safety standards) for emergency escape. If not, it may be impossible to get insurance.
- How does trash work? i.e. Is there a dumpster on the property, or bins out front on trash day?
- Are there working smoke detectors? Is a fire ex nguisher provided?
- Is any furniture included?
- What appliances are included? i.e., stove, fridge, microwave, etc.
- Are u li es included in the rent? If not, how much are u li es? (u li es can include heat and lights (power), internet, phone). These can amount to significant additional expenses you need to plan for!
- What is the length of the rental period? i.e., month by month, yearly, etc.
- How is the rent ex hx x i r hi h e

- What kind of renter's insurance is required, or if it is required? It is highly recommended to have.
- Is a security/damage deposit required? If so, how much is it and how will you be ge ng it back? Always make sure to get a receipt for your damage deposit or you have the op on to pay the deposit at a Service New Brunswick (SNB) o ce.
- Does the loca on fit your needs/lifestyle?
- Who takes care of the outside maintenance? i.e., law care in the summer, shoveling the winter
- Is there a clear contact to reach to have other maintenance issues addressed (leaky faucets, issues with hot water, insect issues, etc.?

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
